









Tricia Cipriano, gave her salute, her final act as president of the class of 2003.



































































By Class Night we were almost there Our excitement could not be contained. So many memories, teachers, and friends, We almost wanted to remain.


But before we bid a final farewell To our teachers we must say, Thanks for the help and encouragement That have gotten us here today.
